### *The Award*

The B.E. Nelligan Award of Merit, instituted in 1985, "honors the person who, as the first Director of Education for the Metropolitan Separate School Board, exemplified the noblest qualities of leadership in Catholic Education".

The Award recognizes "*A person who has made an outstanding and tangible contribution to Catholic Education in Ontario*".

### *Presentation*

A **WALL PLAQUE** with citation and previous recipients is located in the offices of the Association. An **ETCHED GLASS AWARD** with citation is presented to the recipient at the OCSOA Annual General Meeting.

### *Nomination Procedure*

A letter of nomination shall include:

- a rationale describing the outstanding and tangible contribution of the nominee to Catholic Education in Ontario;
- a concise curriculum vitae of the nominee;
- the support of three (3) Active OCSOA Members;
- The Executive-Director must receive eligible nominations by **January 20, 2023**.

### *Selection Process*

- The Executive-Director will forward the nominations to the Awards Committee;
- The Awards Committee shall provide a recommendation to the Board of Directors for ratification;
- the Board of Directors shall decide whether the Award is to be presented. A decision of the Board is final.
